



PROGRAM OFFERINGS

PARENT/CHILD

This is a wonderful way to acquaint yourself and your child with the Montessori way of life. You'll get a chance to observe both your child and the Directress in the classroom environment, and you'll acquire a variety of Montessori principles and actions you can use in your home.

The goals of the Parent-Child Program are:

- to foster the child's development through his or her self-expression within the classroom environment.
- to encourage both large and small motor development, receptive and expressive language development and socio-emotional development.
- to help parents refine their observation skills and give them better understanding and insight into the development of their child.

Program times:

SESSION 1: 9:00-10:30 am Monday and Tuesday (parent and child) & 1:00-2:30 pm every 4th Tuesday of the month (parent only)

SESSION 2: 9:00-10:3 am Wednesday and Thursday (parent and child) & 1:00-2:30 pm every 4th Tuesday of the month (parent only)

The parent and child class meets twice weekly. On the last Tuesday of the month, the regular class is replaced by a parent discussion session with the Directress.
